Solid Waste Advisory Committee

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Purpose

- To meet requirements stipulated by Act 101 of 1988, Chapter 3, Section 303(f) and Section 304(f).
- Requires reporting to DEP of weight or volume of materials recycled by municipal / county programs.
- Municipality reports to county by Feb 15.
- County reports to DEP by April 1.

How is data collected?

- Varies widely from county to county.
- Standardized forms on PROP website.
- County Recycling Coordinator (CRC) sends forms to municipalities.
- Municipalities sends out forms to haulers, vendors, industries, etc.
- Entities return forms to municipality.
- Municipalities send to CRC reviews
- CRC enters data into ReTRAC

Who has Access to Re-TRAC?

- DEP Administrators
- DEP Regional Recycling Coordinators
- County Recycling Coordinators (CRC)
- DEP Management Techs
- Other interested state employees
- Interested parties

Implementation Timeline

- Worked with PROP's Data Management Committee for initial design - completed Dec 2013.
- Beta-testing by 5 counties completed Jan 2014.
- Recommendations processed by early May 2014.
- Transfer of data May 1st.
- Training for users May to October.

How was system developed to meet PA's needs?

- Adjusted materials to meet users' needs.
- Included ability to report "verifiable" data for 904 Performance Grants.
- Added Environmental Equivalencies, a
 Diversion Rate Report & Total Tons Analysis.
- Customized Demographics for Act 83.
- Customized Curbside Program data.

Benefits to Counties/Municipalities?

- Keeps a record of type and amounts of recycled materials.
- Reduces time to assemble and analyze data.
- Reduces time to produce customized & automated reports.
- Frees time to perform other duties.
- Helps justify need for their position.

Benefits to State?

- Reduces time to assemble, analyze and use data.
- Can disseminate data faster when requested.
- Increases data's accuracy.
- Data validates the economic and environmental benefits of recycling.

Continuing Development

- 904 Performance Grant report.
- Adding a system to replace Ecoville.
- Testing of Podium.
- Download of dicentennial demographics.
- Adding additional customized reports.
- Post relevant studies.
- Provide continued training opportunities for data management.
