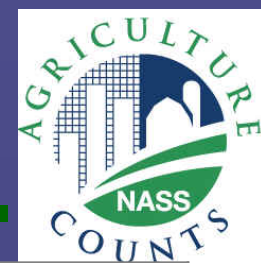
Number of PA Farms, Ag Census

Number of PA Farms, 2007 and comparisons by Size of Farm

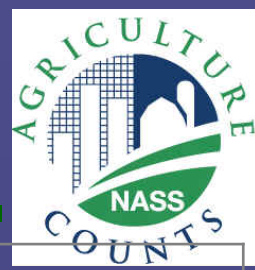

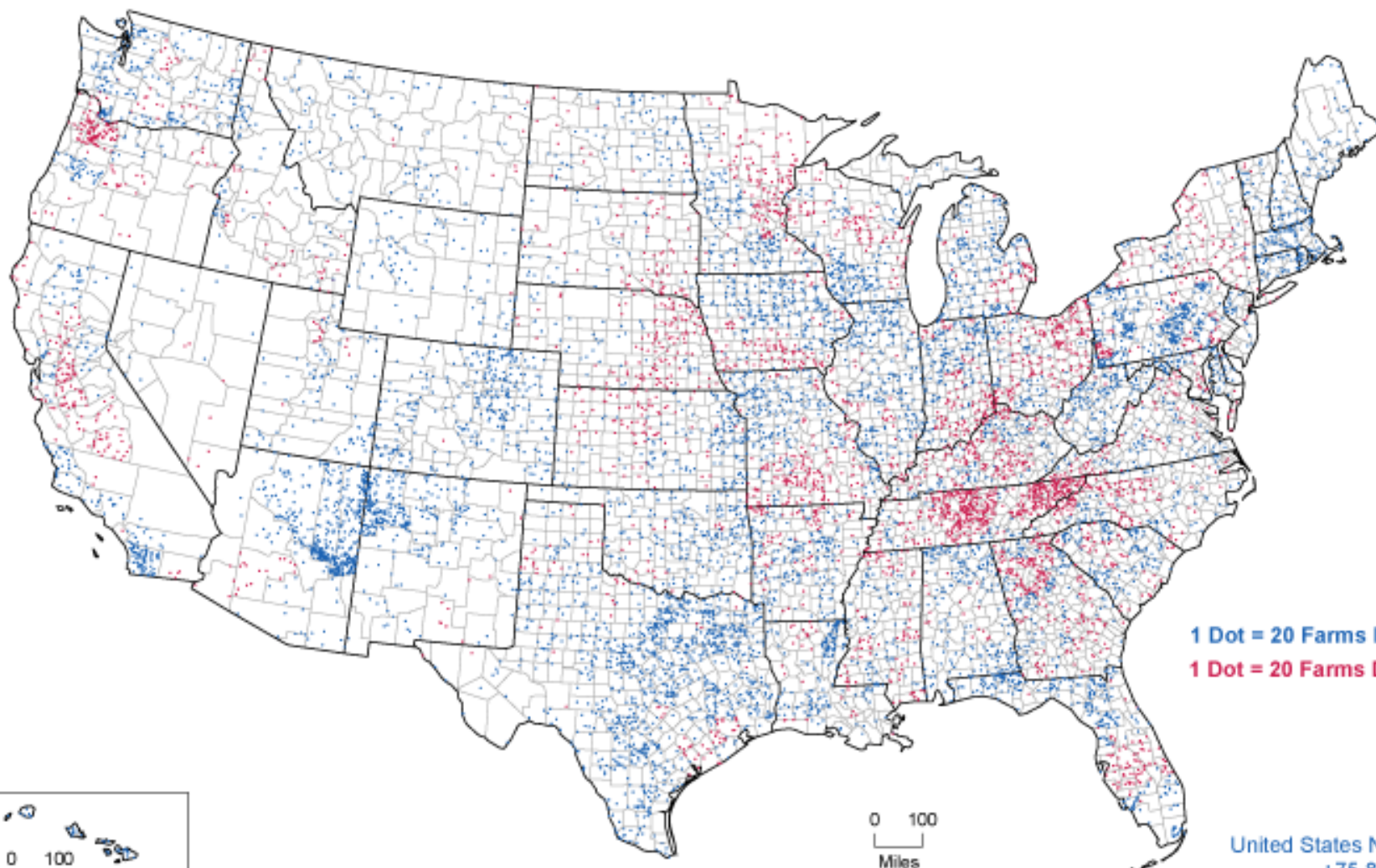

Change in Number of Farms: 2002 to 2007



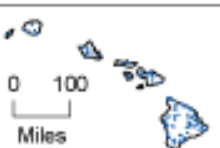

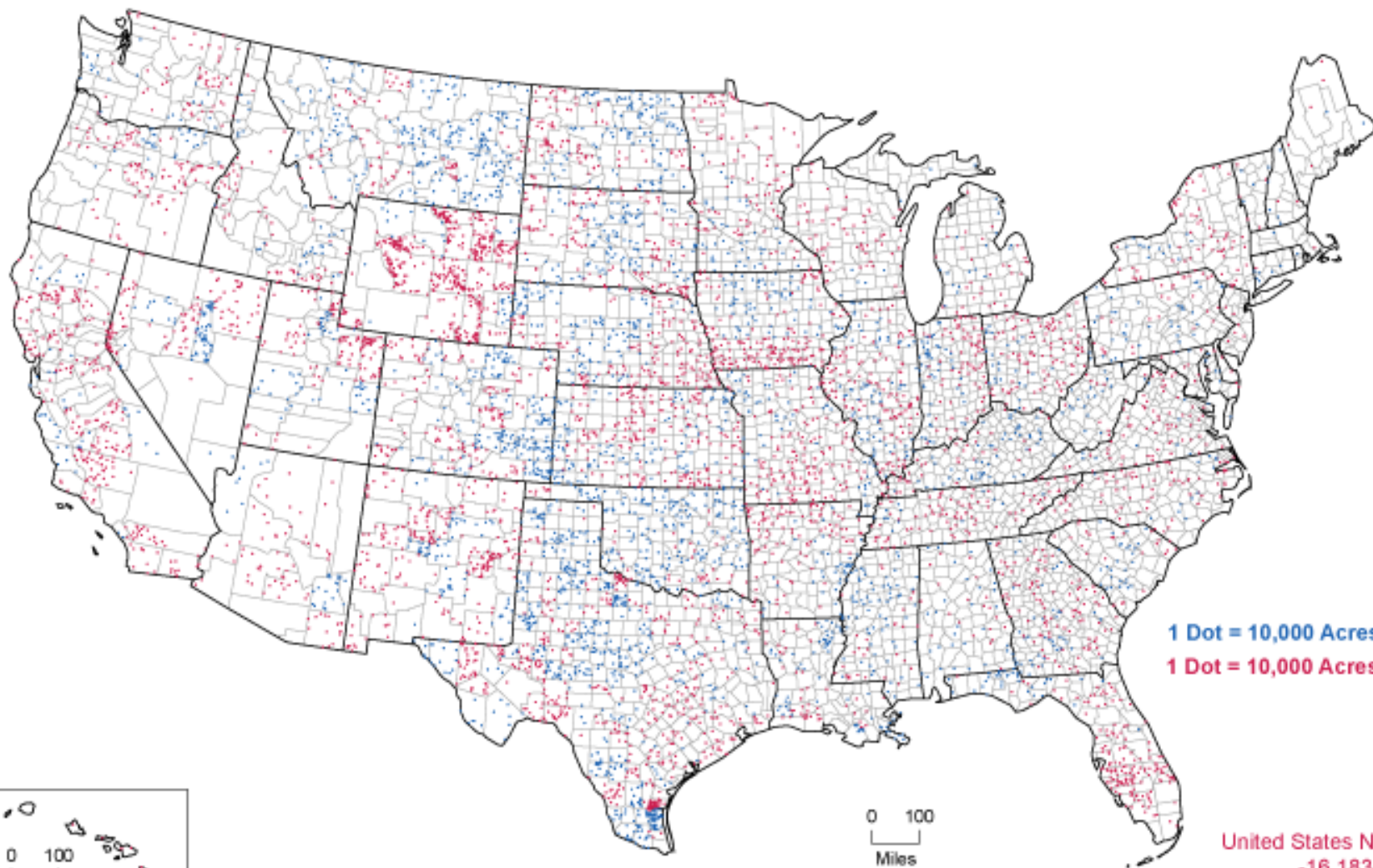

Land in Farms - Change in Acreage: 2002 to 2007

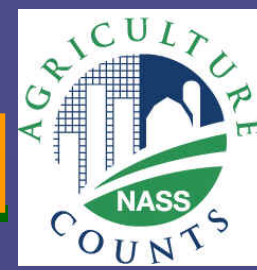

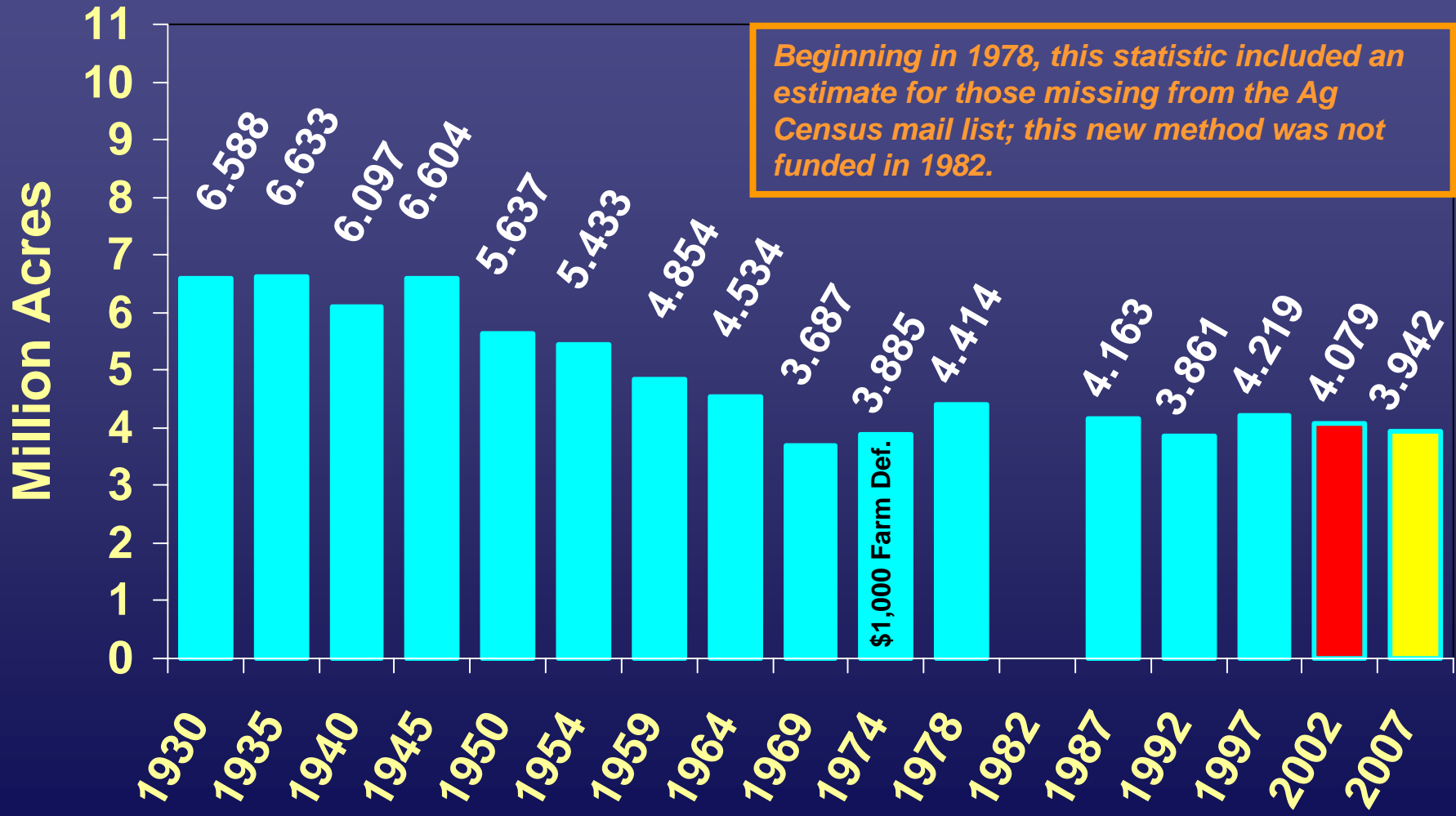

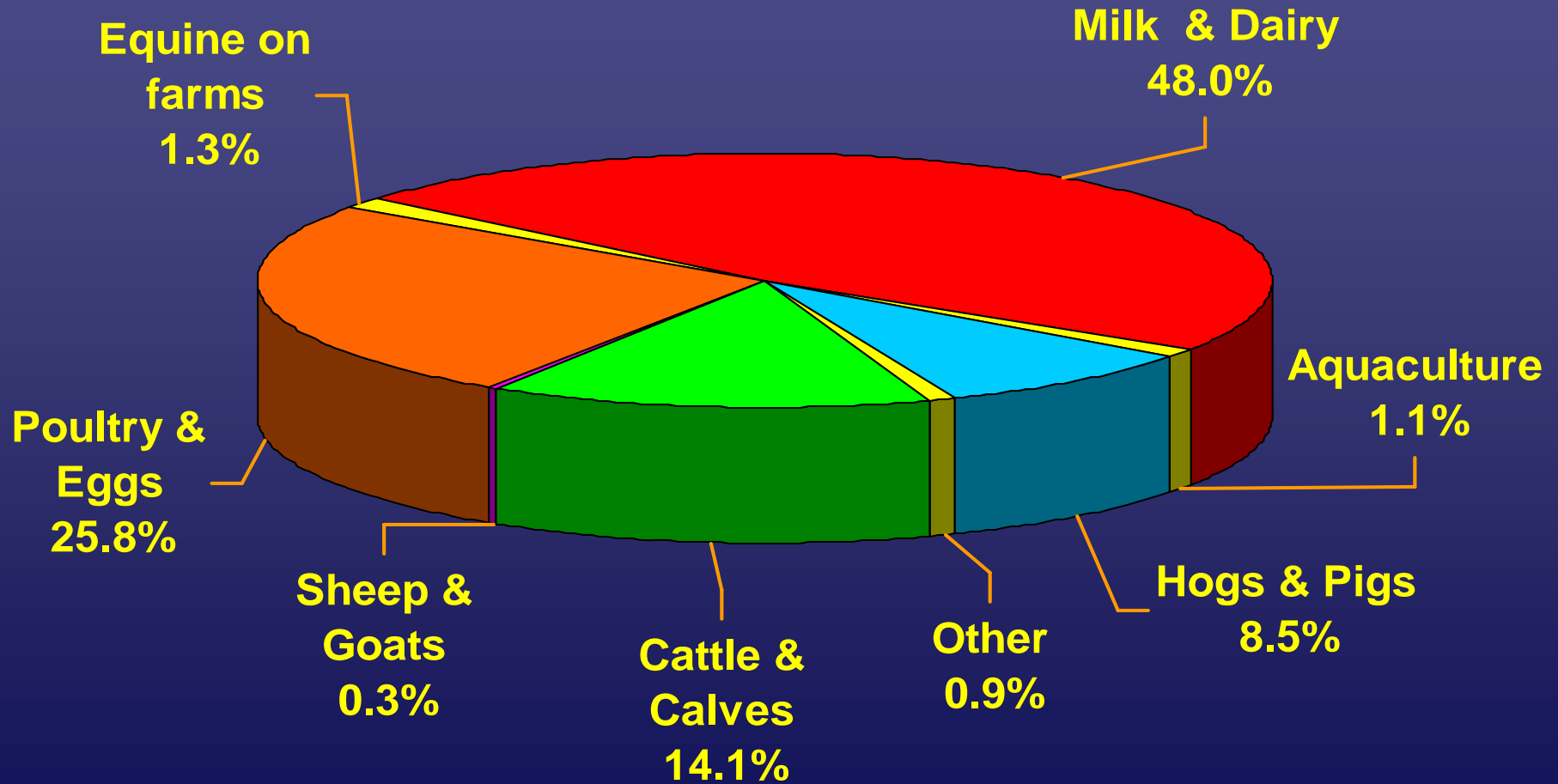
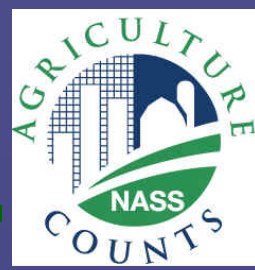
Value of All Agricultural Sales Pennsylvania



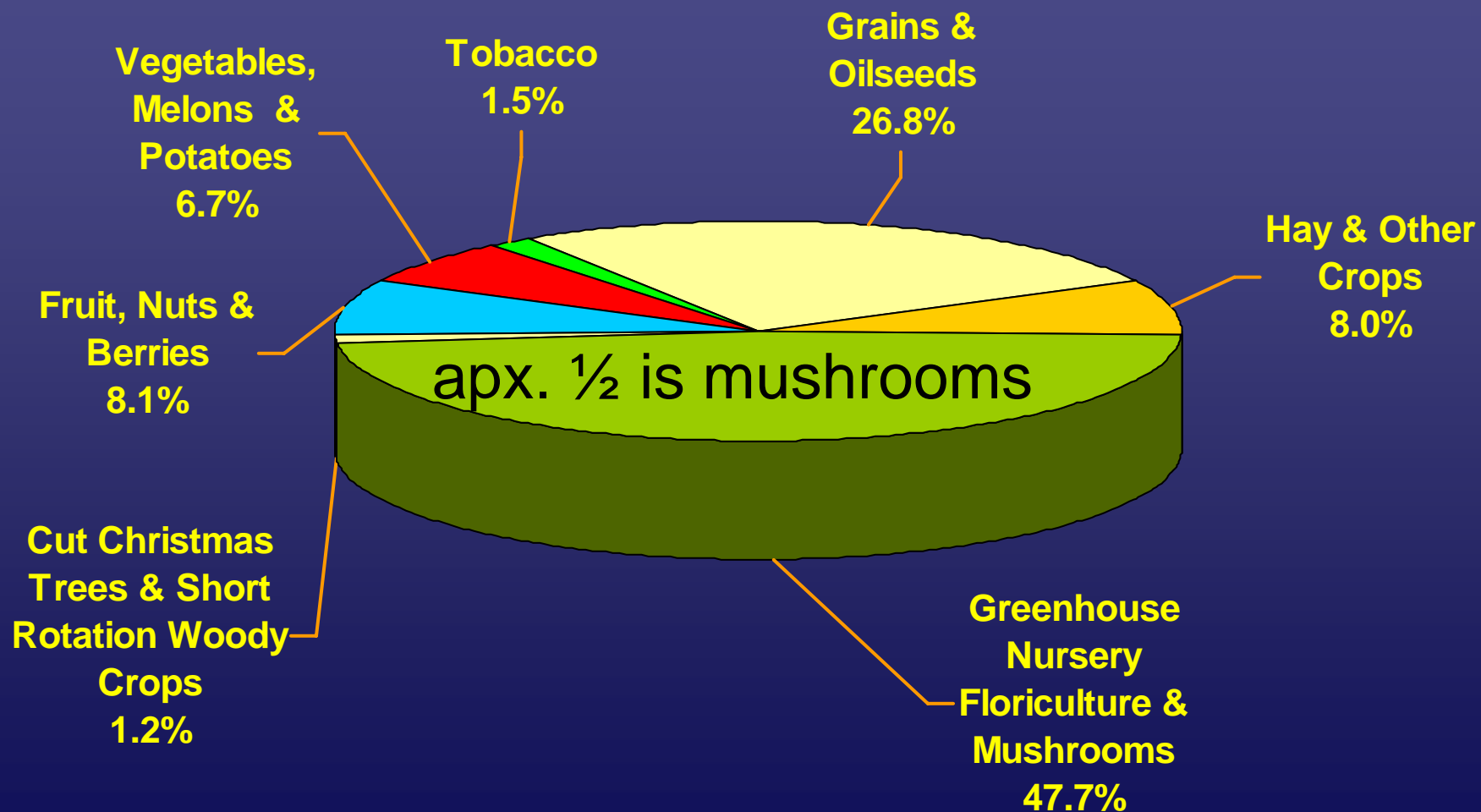
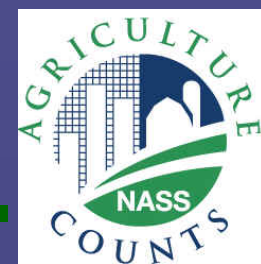

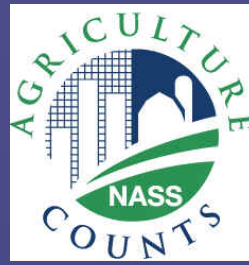


Value of Animal Agricultural Sales Pennsylvania, \$3.9 billion



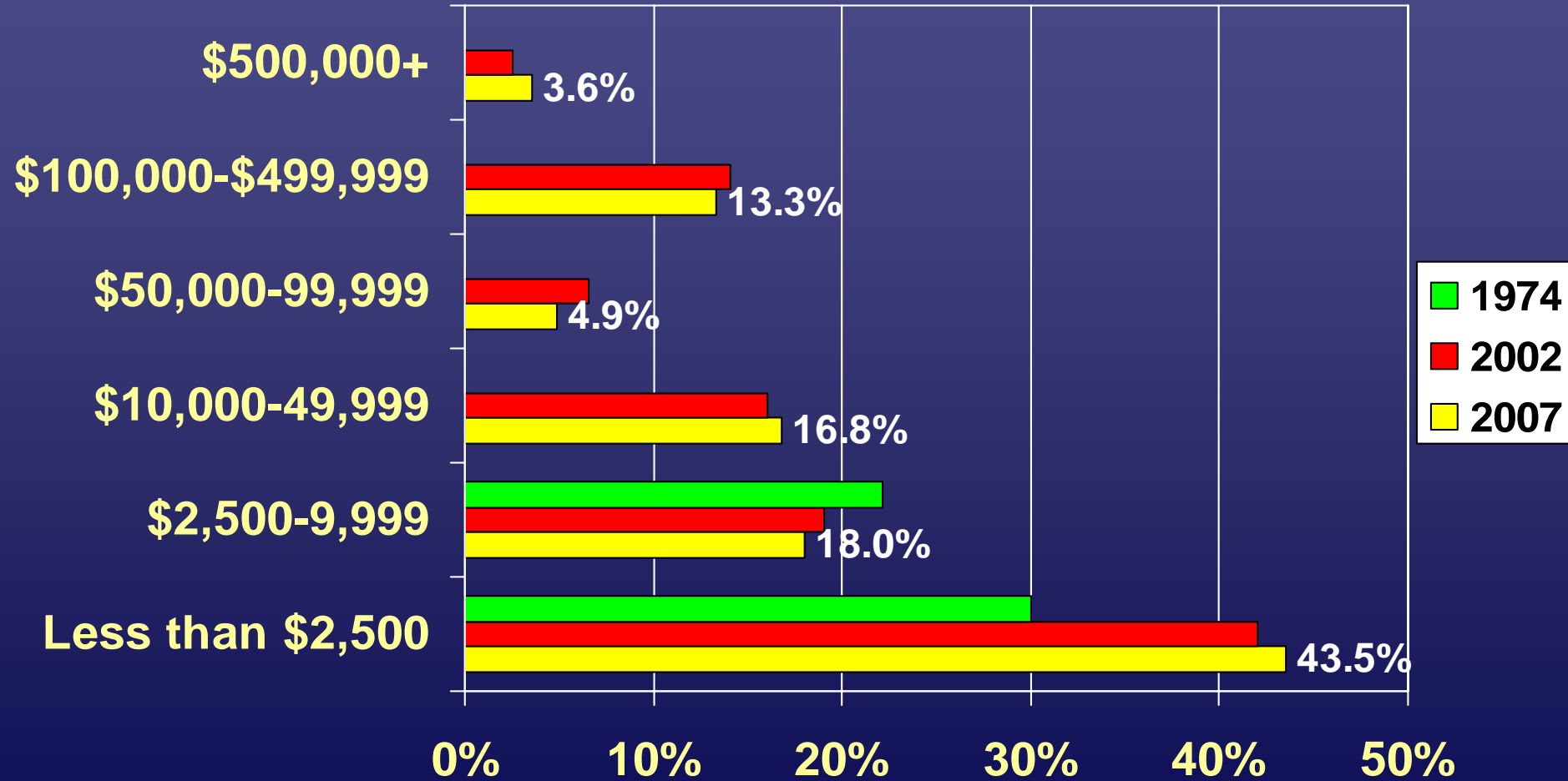

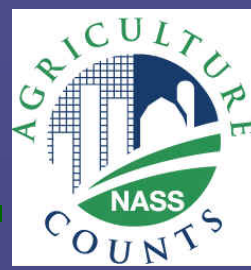
PA All Farms, All Sales & All Land, 2007 by Market Value of Ag Products Sold



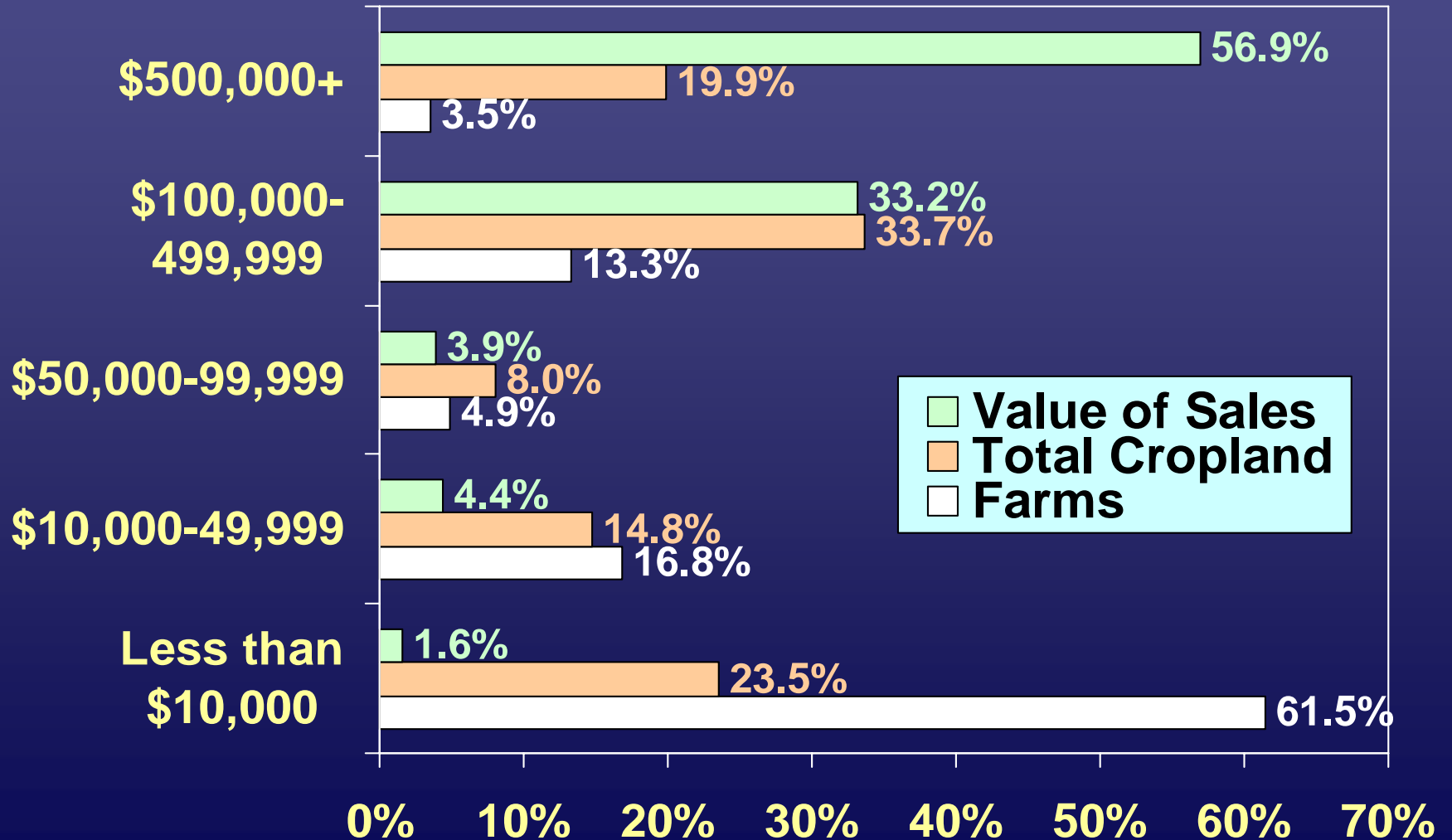

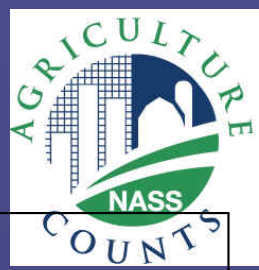


PA All Farms, All Sales & Cropland, 2007 by Market Value of Ag Products Sold



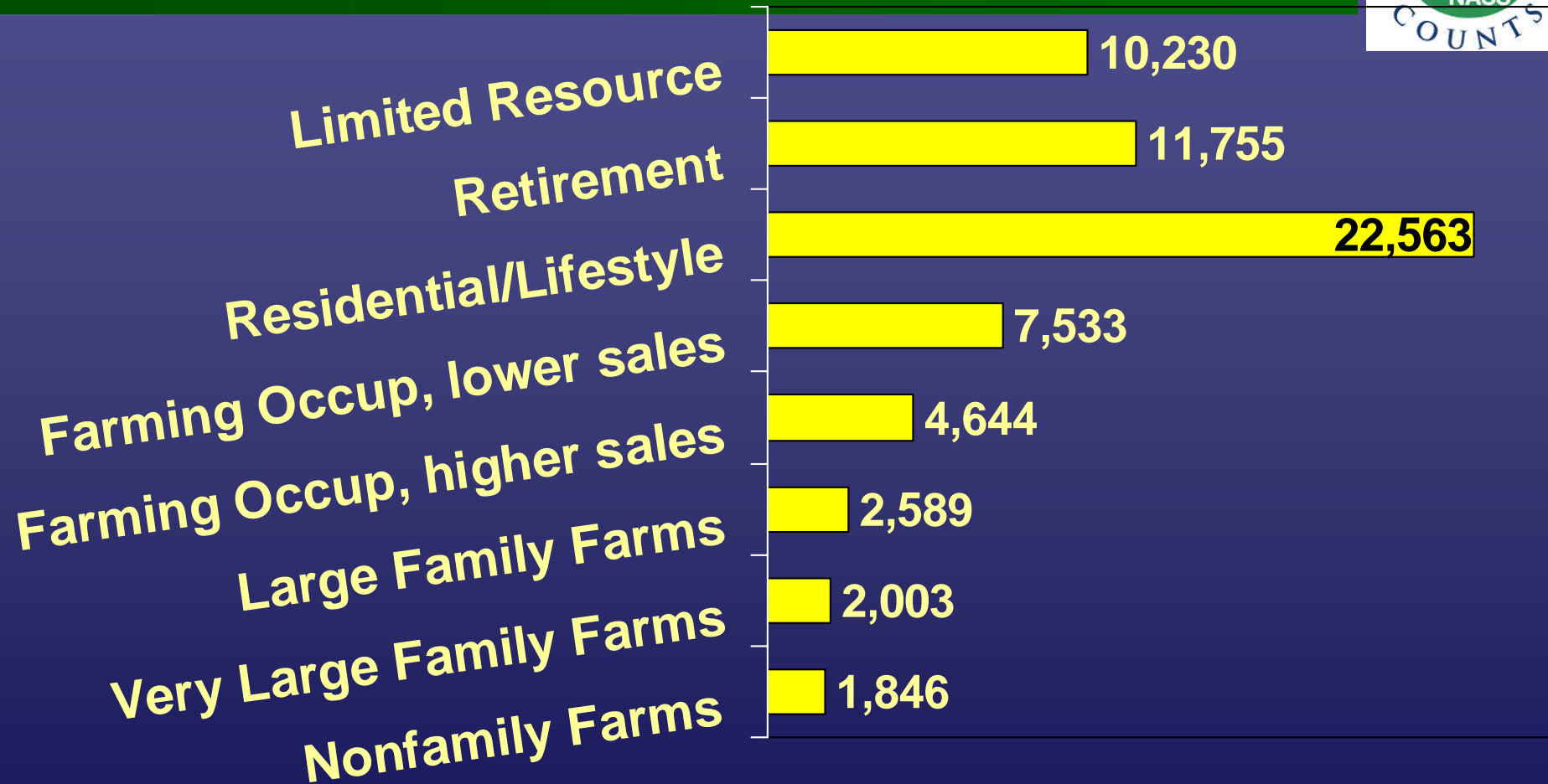

PA Farm Numbers by Type, 2007

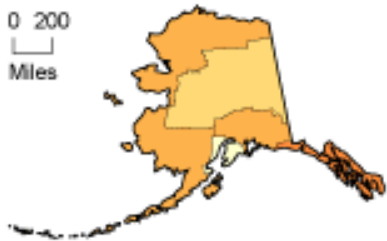

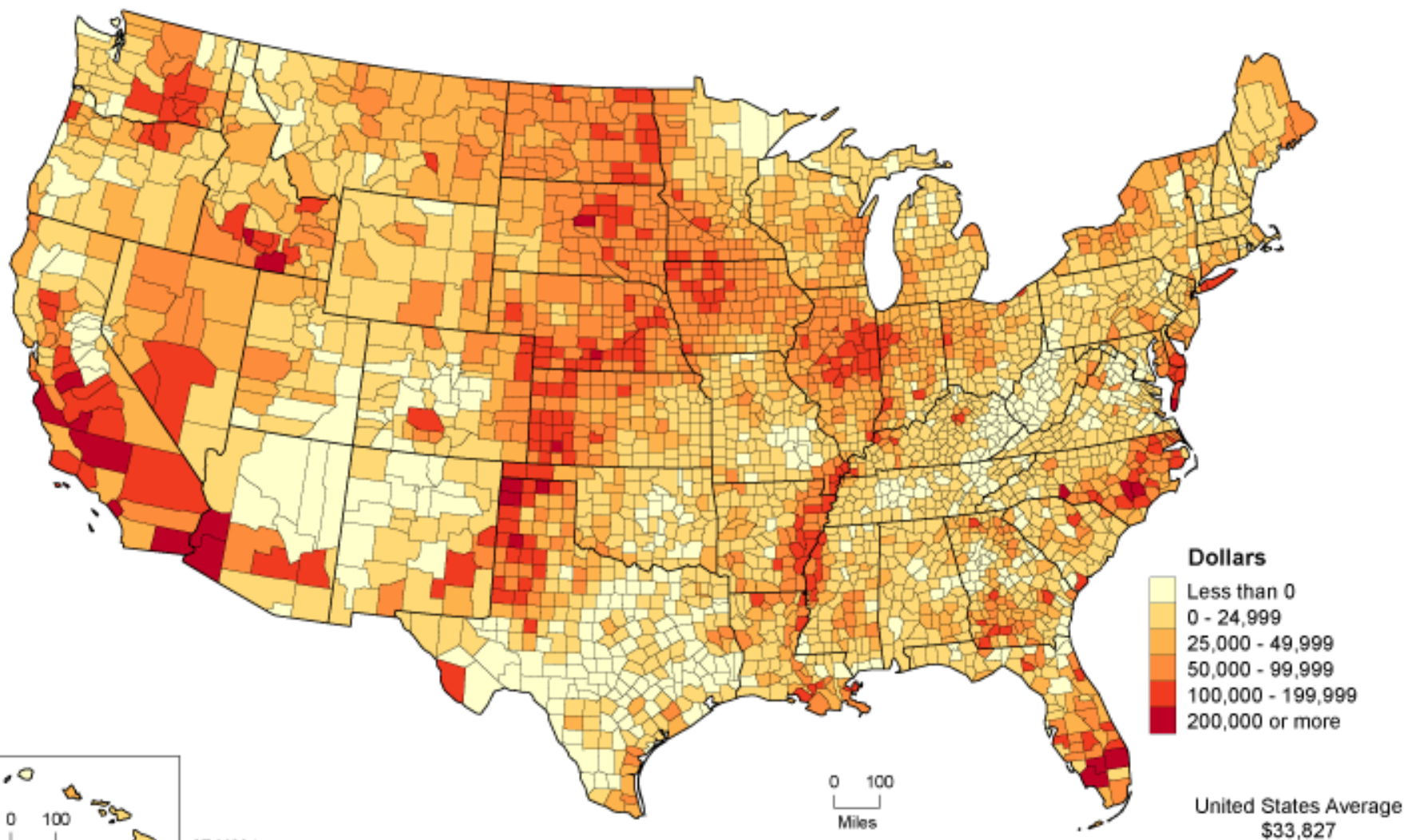

Net Cash Farm Income of Operation, Average per Farm: 2007



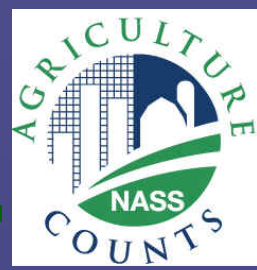

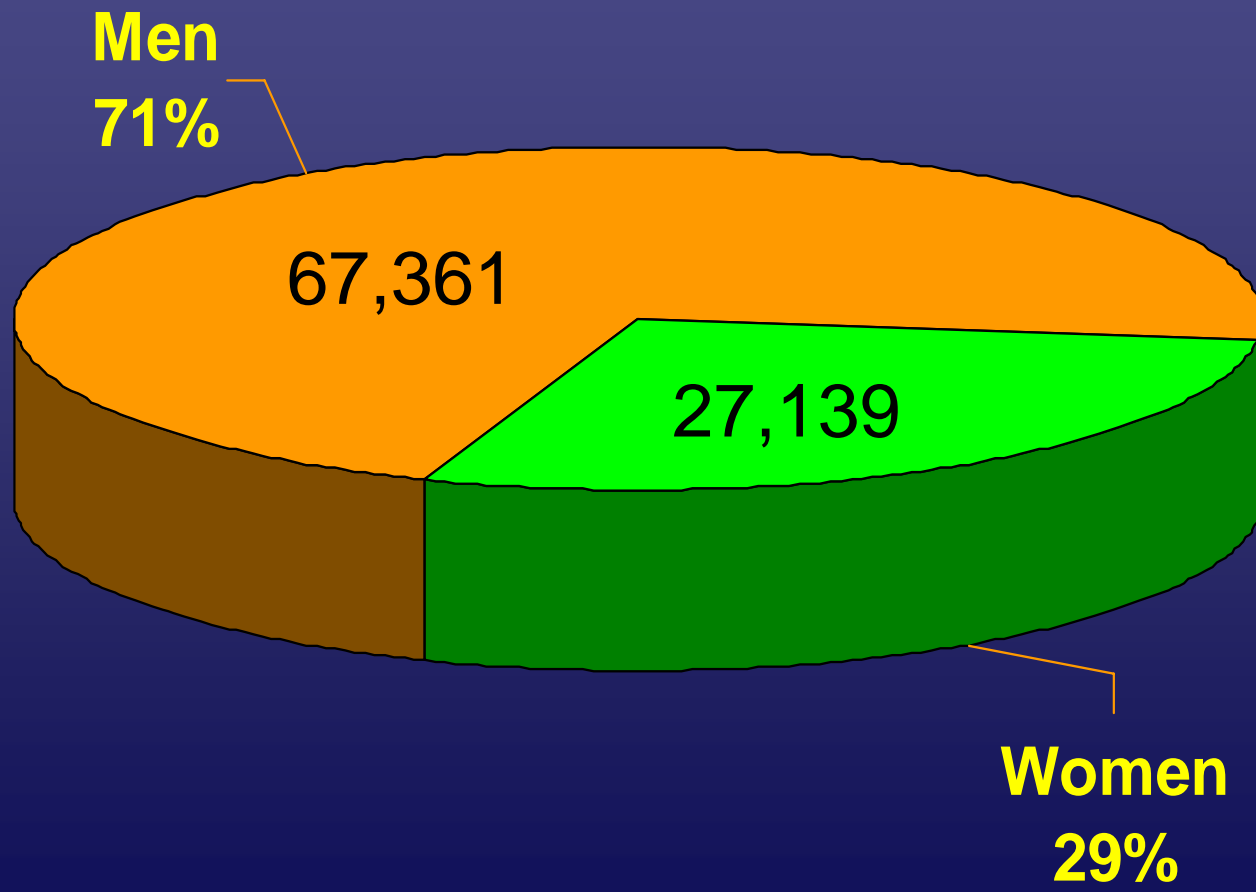
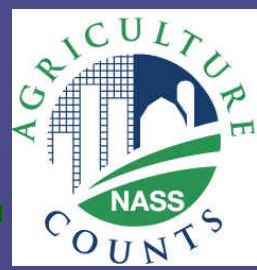
Number of PA Farms, 2007 & comparisons by Type of Organization



Number of PA Farms, 2007 & comparisons by Principal Occupation of Operator

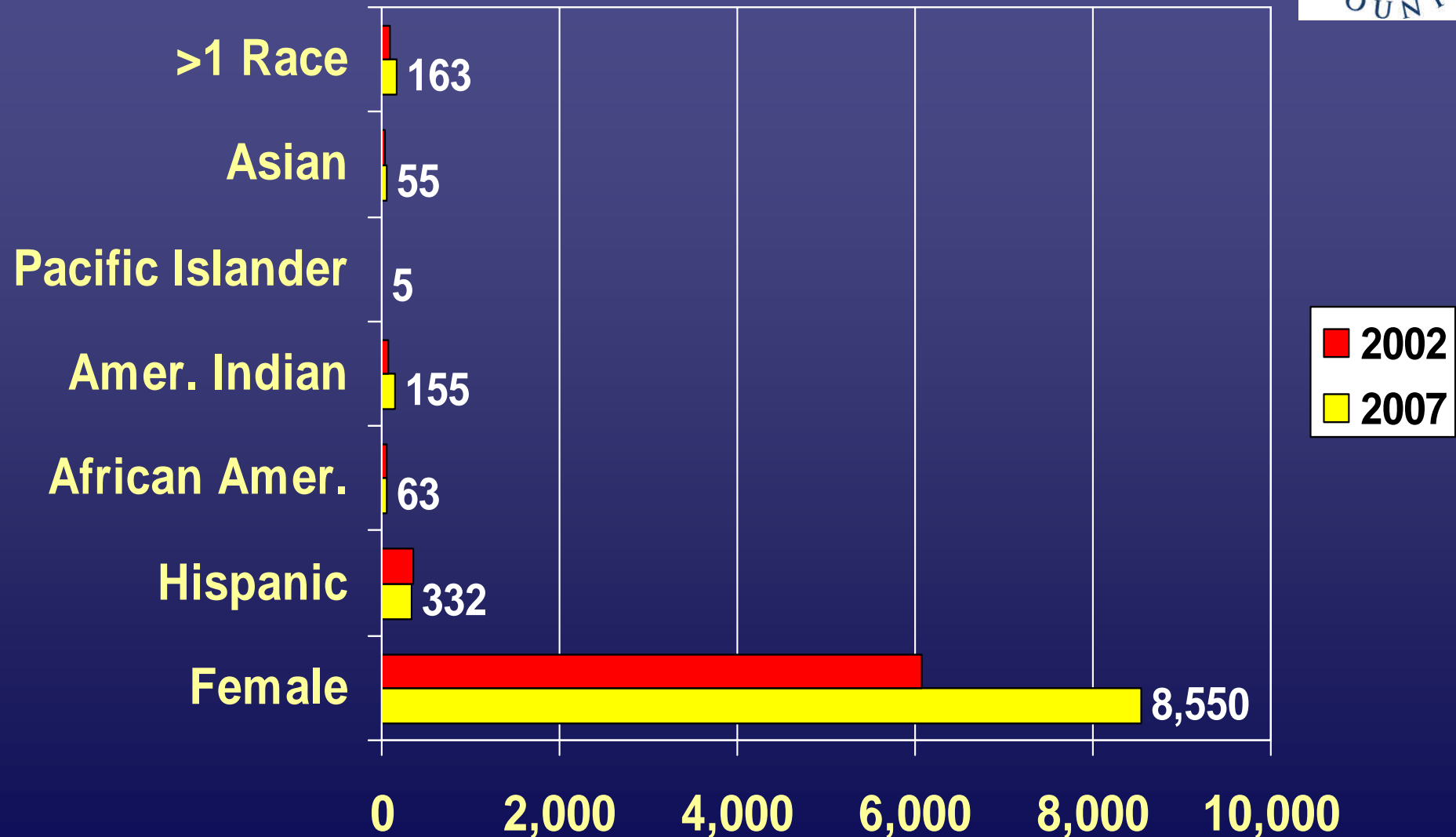
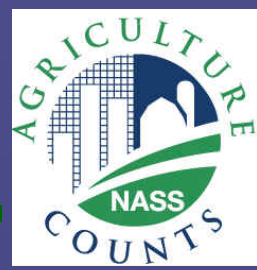


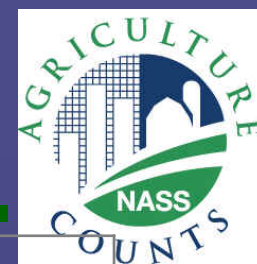

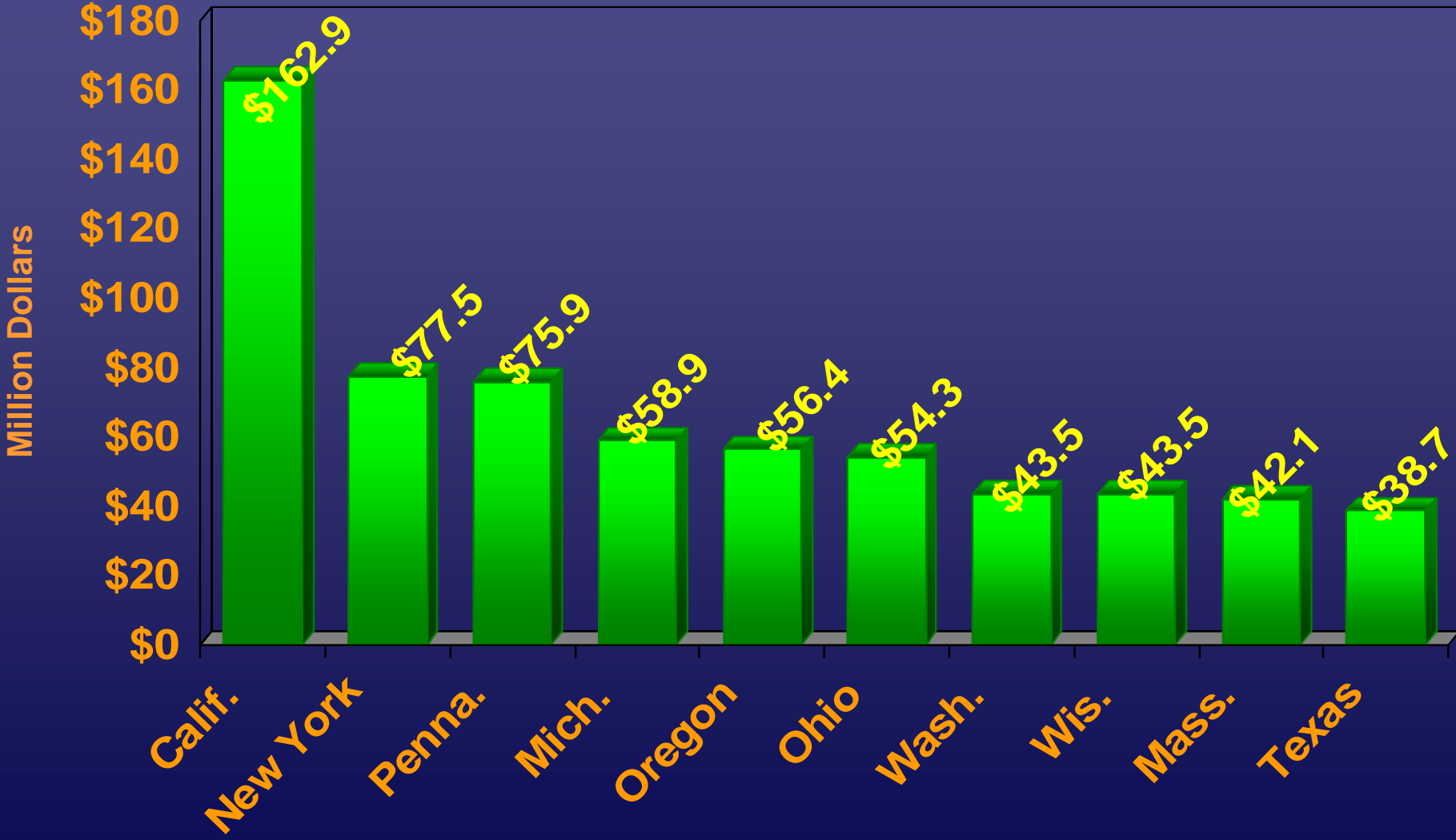
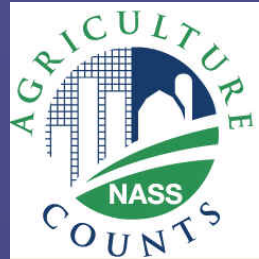
Organic Product Sales Top Ten States in 2007

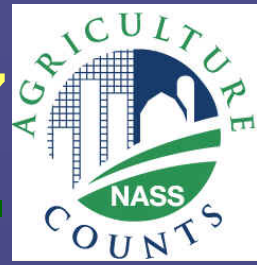

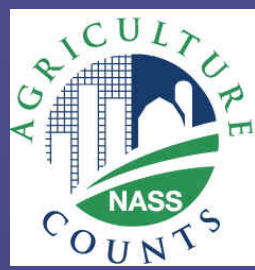




Value of Milk and Other Dairy Products from Cows Sold as Percent of Total Market Value of Agricultural Products Sold: 2007

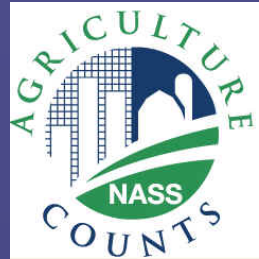


Value of Nursery, Greenhouse, Floriculture, and Sod Sold as Percent of Total Market Value of Agricultural Products Sold: 2007

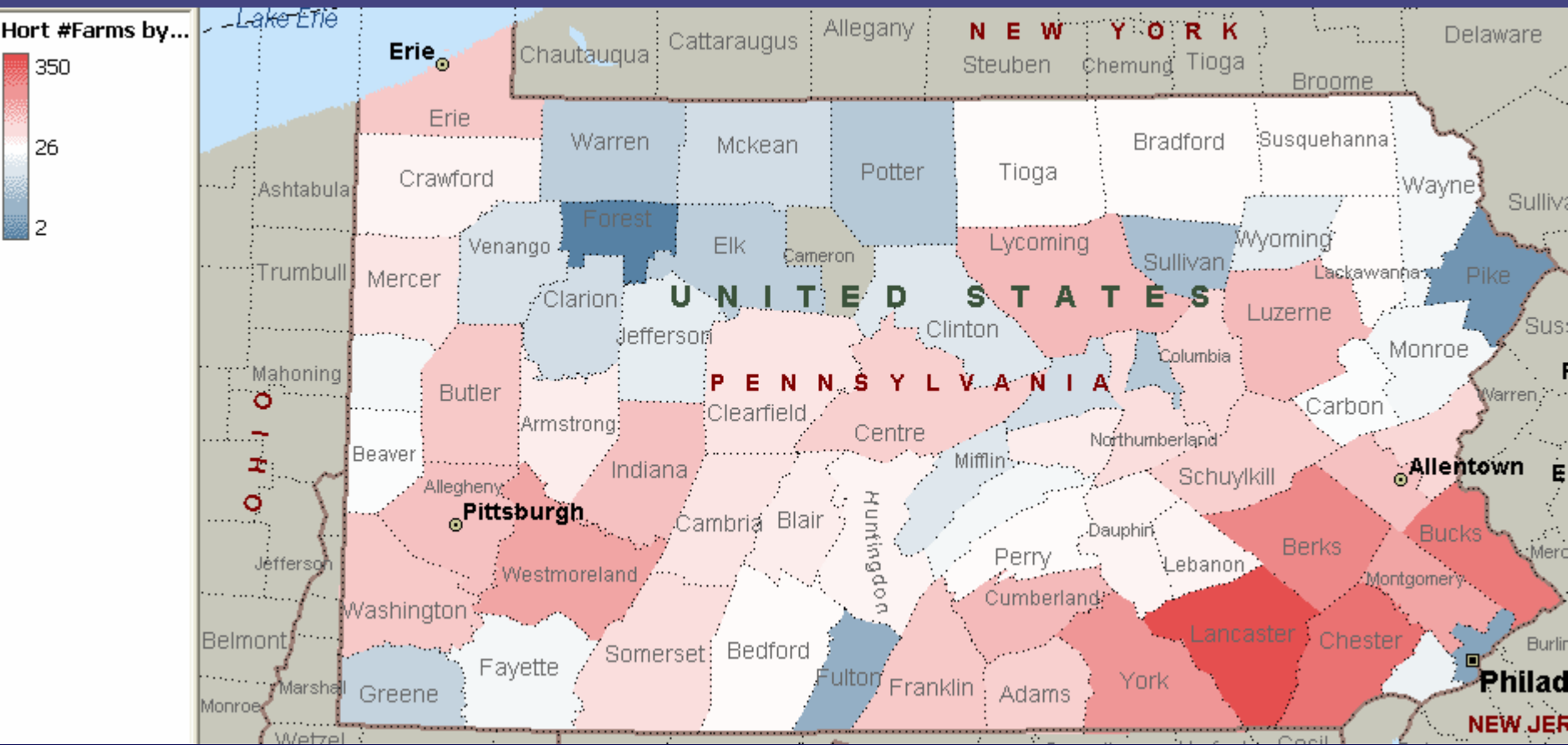

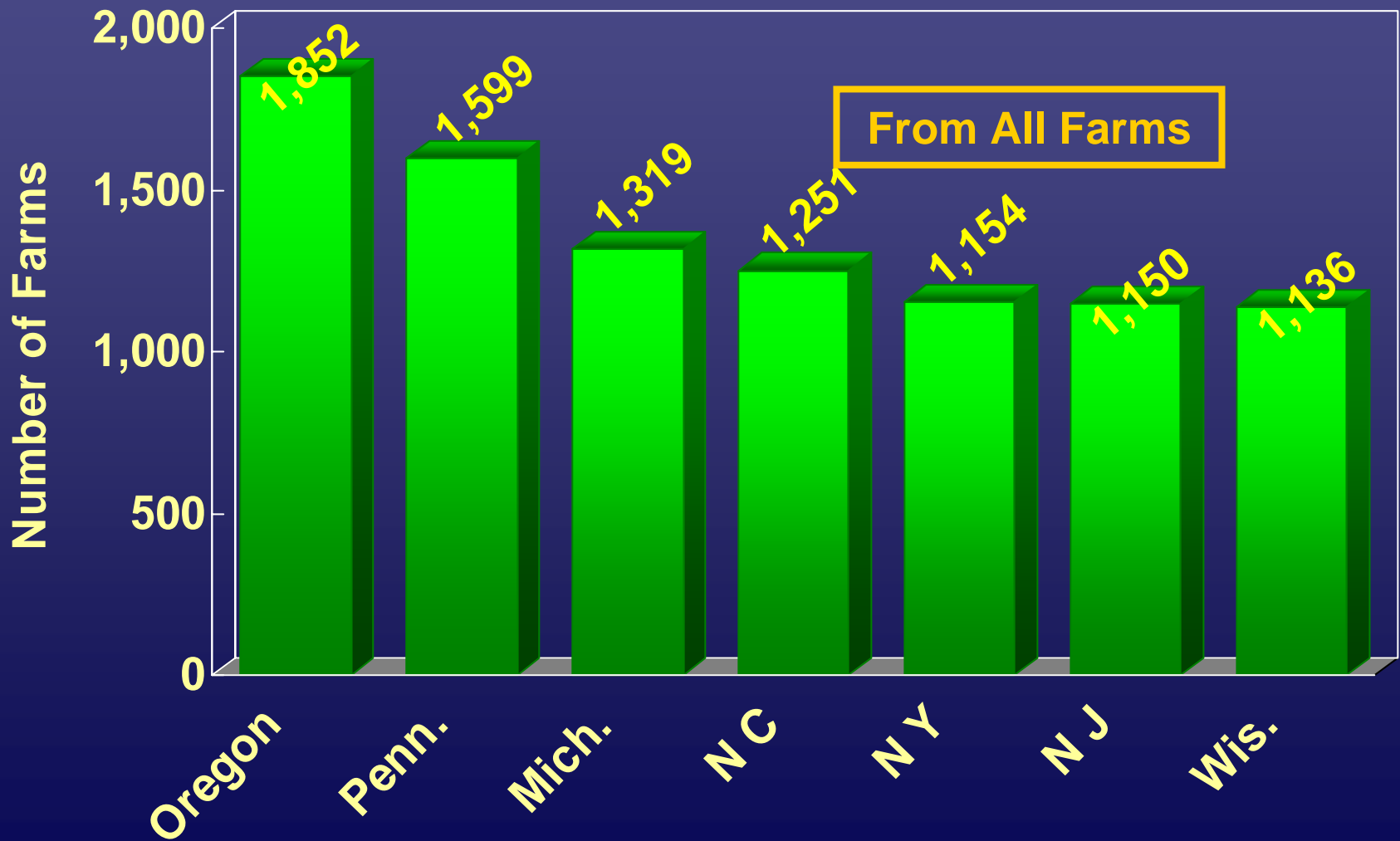
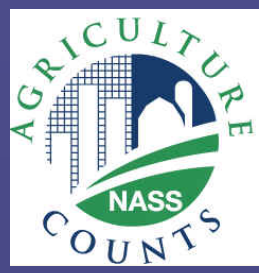


Value of Cut Christmas Trees and Short Rotation Woody Crops Sold as Percent of Total Market Value of Agricultural Products Sold: 2007



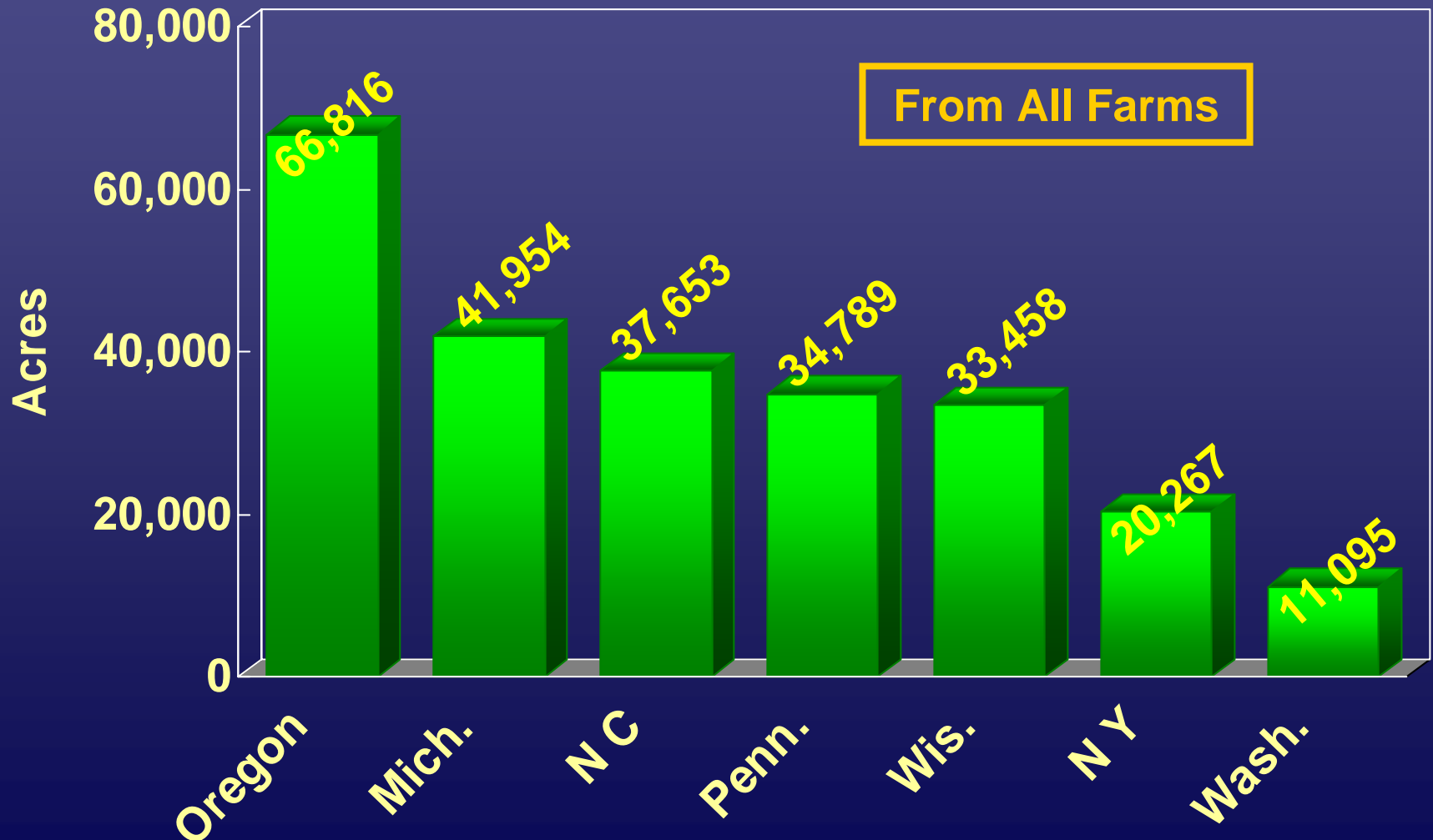
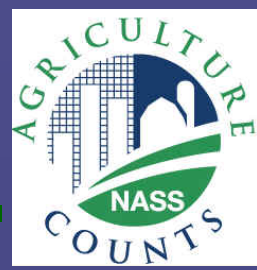
